Cost & Cost Breakdown

\$1,250 Clayton First Baptist Members

Payment Procedure – Trip Cost will be collected on 3 separate dates

- **\$100 Non-Refundable Flight Deposit due upon signing up** (returned after the trip)
- **\$400 Due by December 1** (November fundraising will be subtracted from the \$400)
- **\$850-950 Due by May 20**

- Recruit: A variety of people and professions would be a great contribution to the team.
- Get your passport: Go to the Post Office to set up an appointment, and print an application off of the web: http://travel.state.gov/passport/forms/forms_847.html
- Start Saving
 - Begin to put at least \$50 away each month toward your trip. \$50 a month for 10 months is \$500. Cut back on things you really don't need in order to save money.
