About the Appalachia Ministry Location

- 42% of the population is rural compared to 20% of the national population.
- Third world conditions due to extreme poverty.
- 27 of the 37 poorest counties in the USA are in eastern Kentucky
- 50-80% of the adult population cannot read on an 8th grade level.
- 32% of the children live in poverty.
- Some counties ranked 115 out of 120 in overall health and well being.

Cost Breakdown - \$85 per person (Estimated cost)

- ❖ The cost covers: lodging, transportation, tee shirt, most meals, and ministry items.
- ❖ 2 Step Payment Process
 - \$50 non-refundable deposit due by January 8
 - \$35 second payment due by May 9 (amount based on fund-raiser participation)
- ❖ Fundraiser Information:
 - **Only team members who participate in person at the fundraiser events will receive the benefits of the funds raised.**
 - December 9 – Babysitting Night
 - February 14 – Babysitting Night
 - Other Fundraising Event
- ❖ Discount Information:
 - Financial Assistance (partial and full) is available upon request and is kept confidential.
- ❖ Additional Cost:
 - Food: 2 Lunches, 2 Dinners.

Logistics

- ❖ Transportation:
 - We will be traveling in a 15 passenger van. All drivers who choose to drive their own vehicles separate will be responsible for their own gas.
- ❖ Lodging:

 - Married couples, please keep in mind that the trip is set up on a more frugal system. Therefore, it is more cost effective to put 4 in a room instead of 2. However, if you choose to stay with your spouse there will be an additional cost.
- ❖ Work:

- ❖ Please be prepared to be with the team the entire week. These trips are not designed for individual or small group outings. All team members will be expected to work and participate in every activity.

 - *Sign up as an individual or group on the Outreach Opportunities Board*
 - Backpack Buddies (Pack Bags)
 - Wilmington Street Center (Serve the Homeless)
 - Senior Adult Partnership Program (Establish a partnership or deliver meals)
 - Youth, Christmas Caroling and the Senior Adult Banquet do not count towards this requirement.
