

Children's Minister Position

Clayton First Baptist Church prayerfully seeks an individual to lead our congregation's children in their walk with our Savior.

The position of Children's Minister is a part-time position (20-30 hours/week) reporting directly to the Pastor, available immediately. The primary responsibility of this position is to plan and coordinate a comprehensive program for the preschool and children's ministry of the church. The program should undergird the spiritual, emotional and social development of the children as it relates to their becoming and growing as Christians. The position also works closely with parents and volunteers in carrying out the duties of this position.

The successful candidate will:

- Be a strong Christian seeking to follow God's will for his/her life
- Have a Bachelor's degree, preferably in an area related to planning and delivering children's programs
- Preferably be enrolled in a seminary or divinity school, with studies focused on children's ministry

Job duties will include:

- Organize and lead activities for children (birth through fifth grade) which constitute quality Christian education including
- Coordinate with the Pastor and other staff the plans for children including, but not limited to
 - Children's Sermons
 - Praise Kids
 - Children's Church
 - Music programs
 - Missions organizations
- Work with Enlistment Committee to help recruit individuals to work with children as teachers and leaders for Sunday School, Church Training and Music and provide training for volunteer working in these areas
- Develop an annual budget for children's activities and operate within the approved budget
- Serve as the staff liaison to the Child Development Center, and work with the Director to facilitate use of shared space between the CDC and the church
- Contribute a weekly column to the church newsletter
- Perform other pastoral duties as determined and assigned by the Pastor
